Many individuals are interested in healthcare careers as Nurse Aides, but may lack the necessary knowledge, skills, and resources to successfully complete the clinical training and testing. The Employment Skills Center educates potential candidates to better prepare them to excel in healthcare training and careers.

# CERTIFIED NURSE AIDES ARE IN DEMAND

According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, employment of Nurse Aides is expected to grow by 20 percent from 2010 to 2020, faster than the average for all occupations. Job prospects for Nurse Aides with formal training are excellent, particularly in long-term care facilities.

#### NURSE AIDE TRAINING CURRICULUM

#### PRE-CLINICAL TRAINING AT ESC

Employment Skills Center provides 3 weeks of classroom instruction to qualified applicants. Topics include:

- Concepts and principles for nursing assistants
- Body systems and basic human anatomy
- Current topics in healthcare and science
- Healthcare terminology
- Mathematics for the Nurse Aide
- Study skills and test-taking strategies
- Teamwork
- Personal responsibility
- · Professionalism and ethics for healthcare
- Stress management

#### SCHOLARSHIPS AND SUPPORT

Admission into our program is selective. Once enrolled, students are expected to display the dedication and commitment expected of a healthcare professional. Those who successfully complete our program receive:

- A scholarship to Harrisburg Area Community College's state-certified 3-week clinical Nurse Aide training held at an area nursing facility
- Payment of fees to take the PA state Nurse Aide Registry certification examination
- Continued support for each student as they continue through the clinical program, CNA certification process, job search, and further career exploration and development
